• Follow up on Downtown Reimagined Zoom meeting -

All in attendance noted dismay with the consultant's confirmation that the parameters provided to them for the study area were set to only cover Main Street from Elm to Christie Street. It was noted the Board had been told many times - from the start of the process - the whole downtown from Elm in the south to the rail tracks to the north would be considered as part of the process. It was recognized redoing Main Street - an only part of Main Street at that - would leave a great deal on the table, but it is recognized ongoing communication issues are not likely to be overcome. It was noted that the interest in removing parking spaces on Main Street would prove devastating to retailers. As well, putting a bike lane on Main due to width limitations would also necessitate removal of parking from one entire side of the street. The consensus was hope that subsequent meetings would be much better than the initial DIA meeting.
